



### 13.30 Fónadaco

Architect-designer Alessandra Marino is a tour de force in Rome, and this is her most visionary, ambitious project to date – the occupation of an entire street, anchored by the three-storey Fónadaco. It encompasses a restaurant, a cocktail bar, a tearoom, a chocolatier, a show kitchen, three guest suites, a day spa and a series of intimate, connected galleries (above) that display modern and contemporary art and design,

launched in 2017 with a Gabriella Crespi retrospective. It's a homely environment, with fully stocked bookcases, photos and Livio de Simone fabrics dotted about.
